



RULES & REGULATIONS

OWNERS, TRAINERS AND JOCKEYS

- All racing personnel, including owners and trainers must be licensed prior to participation in racing at Wyoming Downs and fingerprints and photos must be on file with the WPMC.
- All trainers are presumed to know applicable rules and regulations of the WPMC and are responsible for the condition of any horse they enter to race.
- The owner, trainer and/or authorized agent is responsible for any weight carried by their horse.
- Wyoming Downs will not be and is not responsible for any injury to any personal property or any horse at any time or any part of its premises.
- Trainers are responsible for having all horses they send to the main track to work to report the horse's name and distance to be worked to the Official Clocker.
- No horse shall be allowed to start in any race unless a valid Foal Certificate is on file with the Racing Secretary and the horse has been officially tattooed under its upper lip. All horses must be tattooed prior to entry.
- Permission for any change of equipment that a horse earned in a previous race must be obtained from the Stewards. A change of any blinker equipment must be approved by the Starter and reported to the Racing Secretary at the time of entry.
- All horses must carry their equipment to post, except by permission of the Stewards.
- Horses will not be allowed to run without shoes (barefoot).
- No ponies or other animals are allowed in the Paddock.
- Trainers are responsible for having their horse in the paddock at the proper time. If a horse arrives late, resulting in any delay of the post parade, scratching the horse or delay of post time, the responsible trainer will be fined.
- Permission to school horses in the paddock must first be obtained from the Paddock Judge. The Paddock Judge can be reached through the Racing Office. Any person accompanying the horse is required to wear a schooling vest available in the Racing Office.

- Proper attire in the paddock for owners, trainers, jockeys and grooms is required at all times. As our racing program is available on our in-house television system, it is imperative that we adhere to proper attire.
- All pony persons taking horses to the post in the post parade must wear shirts and/or jackets, helmet covers and use Wyoming Downs provided saddle towels, which will be available for purchase in the Racing Office. Pony persons will be required and expected to keep their mounts well groomed and their tack clean. Grooms will be provided with number vests, which are located in the Racing Office. All grooms must wear the numbered vests when with their horse in the paddock and walking rings.
- All persons astride a horse while Wyoming Downs are prohibited from using a cell phone and are subject to the fines from any violation.
- Each and every horse entered to race shall be subjected to a racing soundness exam on race day. The exam shall be conducted by the Track Veterinarian and occur outside of the stall to which the horse is assigned. The Track Veterinarian will keep a record of all such exams.
- No alterations shall be made for any entry after closing, except to correct an error.
- Horsemen must have an apprentice jockey engaged before claiming the apprentice allowance. Such allowances can only be waived by the Stewards.
- Jockeys and/or their representative must be present at the time of the draw.
- Jockeys must be named at the time of entry and no jockey may be named to ride more than one horse per race.
- Jockeys must fill all riding engagements unless released by the trainer or excused by the Stewards.
- No jockey may wear any sponsor or other logo without prior approval of Wyoming Downs.
- Claiming time ends at fifteen (15) minutes before each race is run.
- Horses claimed sold or transferred at Wyoming Downs will not constitute any entitlement to stalls.
- An owner must have started a horse at the then current meet at Wyoming Downs or have a Steward approved certificate to claim at Wyoming Downs.
- Manure must be deposited and covered at all times in designated bins. All trash, bottles and cans must be deposited in designated trash receptacles. No trash is

allowed in the manure pits. As this is both a safety and a health matter, no exceptions apply. Failure to comply will result in immediate eviction and fines.

- Applicant shall properly supervise all of his employees, invitees and agents.
- Applicant shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations and abide by the rules and regulations of the Wyoming Pari-Mutuel Commission (“WPMC”) and WR, including, but not limited to, these terms and conditions.
- Applicant warrants that he and each of his employees are licensed by the WPMC, and that each of them shall have a valid picture license worn on their person AT ALL TIMES while on premises.
- All dogs must be licensed vaccinated and registered with Racing Office. Unregistered dogs are not permitted in the stable areas. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS. All dogs must be tied up or on a leash. Any dog or other animal deemed by Wyoming Downs to be a nuisance shall be immediately removed.
- Owners, trainers and stable employees must park in the areas designated by WR. Violators are subject to fine; and vehicles are subject to removal at owner’s expense and liability.
- Horses are permitted on main track oval ONLY during training hours posted at the entrance of the track oval.
- Horses must occupy only the stalls assigned on the Stall Use Application. Any horse found in an unassigned stall or a stall assigned to another will be removed from the premises at the owner’s expense and liability.
- Horses must each have a negative Coggins test valid through August 17, 2008, which must be filed with the Racing Office prior to arrival to the premises.
- Motorized vehicles are not permitted in the Stable Area, excepting the designated area for shipping in or out of horses. All vehicles must be parked in their applicable designated parking areas or are subject to being towed at owner’s expense and liability.
- Firearms and fireworks are strictly prohibited at Wyoming Downs. Possession of either is grounds for immediate ejection from premises.
- All areas of the premises, including all stables, living quarters, and vehicles are subject to inspection and surveillance by security and applicable law enforcement agencies at any and all times.
- Any funds deposited with the horsemen’s bookkeeper for the purpose of claiming a horse must be in cash or a certified or cashier’s check. Wyoming Downs may at its election, hold all Foal papers pending satisfaction of any unpaid balances.

- All two-year olds must be properly schooled and approved by the Starter before being allowed to start a race.
- Every horse participating in a race must be saddled in the paddock at least twenty (20) minutes before the scheduled post parade.
- Any horse with a shoe with a turndown of more than one-quarter inch (1/4") will not be allowed on the dirt course.
- The stewards reserve the right to substitute one jockey for another, at their discretion.
- Scratches will be considered by the Stewards upon submission.
- Riders must be named by the closing of entries.
- Scratch time is 7:30 A.M. the Day of the Race.
- Horses Shipping into Wyoming Downs receiving barn for training must arrive by 8:00 A.M.
- Ship In Times:

Post Time: 1:05 p.m.

Races 1 through 5 must arrive by 10:40 a.m.

Races 6 through last must arrive by 11:40 a.m.

RULES & REGULATIONS

STABLE AREA

- Sleeping in any stalls, feed rooms, or tack rooms is strictly prohibited.
- Cooking in tack rooms or any other part of the stable area is expressly prohibited. Any cooking appliance found will be confiscated and disposed of immediately and any violators may be immediately ejected from the premises. As this is a health and safety issue, there are no exceptions.
- Any feed or tack room, or any other storage must be authorized and assigned in writing by the Racing Office prior to any occupancy. Any person found occupying stalls or rooms without such written approval is subject to a fine and ejection from the premises.
- Painting, pasting, posting on any walls of the barns, stables or stalls is expressly prohibited.
- Smoking is not allowed in horse stalls, feed rooms, under shed rows or near any flammable materials. Violators are subject to immediate ejection from the premises.
- An owner, trainer, or jockey may log an unlicensed guest onto the premises but must present Security with a valid picture identification, log them into the log book and bear any and all responsibility for the conduct and safety of any such guest.
- Intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter the stable area. Any person found in such condition may be immediately ejected from the premises and reported to the Stewards.
- Parking of any stable personnel is permitted in designated areas only.
- Horses must be walked to and from the main track and throughout the stable area. Horses are expressly prohibited from galloping in the stable area.
- All licensed personnel in the stable area must wear and have their identification visible in plain view. Any violation will be reported to the Stewards.
- No stable shall have in their employ any minor under the age of 16 years of age, except as may be permitted by applicable laws of the State of Wyoming.
- Any stable employee discharged by any trainer must be immediately reported to Security.

- No licensee shall have on his person, or among his personal effects, while at the premises, a hypodermic syringe or needle, nor any controlled substances, medicines, or drugs unless prescribed by a licensed physician.
- No licensee shall carry or exhibit any deadly weapon, including but not limited to, guns or knives, while at the premises.
- Trainers shall provide pistol grips for use on any water hoses. No water hose is to be used without such a control nozzle. Violators are subject to fine.
- No ice machines, washing machines, or other appliances are allowed in the stable area without prior written approval of the Racing Office.
