



Wyoming Downs Rules & Regulations

For the safety of patrons and horses, we ask that you please observe the following rules and regulations when visiting Wyoming Downs.

Alcohol

No alcoholic beverages or glass containers may be brought to any area of the racetrack including parking areas.

Other Food and Beverage

No outside food, beverages, or coolers are permitted on the premises. Barbeques are not permitted in any area, including the infield and parking lots.

Chairs and Other Objects

Folding Chairs are permitted in the Stretch Run Apron and Cowpoke Corner if placed a safe distance away from fences and railings. Folding chairs are not permitted in the Clubhouse, Grandstand, or other locations at the racetrack.

We ask that you avoid bringing any objects that are likely to frighten the horses. This includes, but is not limited to, balloons, balls, frisbees, tents awnings, whistles, or other noise making devices.

Firearms

Please note that firearms are not permitted at any time on the racetrack premises.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any Clubhouse, Grandstand, or Stretch Run seating area.

Vehicles, Bicycles, and Parking

No overnight parking is allowed. "Tail-gate" parties are not permitted before, after, or during the races. Parking at the racetrack does not create a bailment and Wyoming Downs is not responsible for damage to your vehicle or loss or theft of contents. Vehicles may be towed or moved in the event Wyoming Downs determines it is necessary for safety or security reasons or if otherwise illegally parked. Please pay attention to all directional and safety signage.

Bicycles must be parked and locked in designated bicycle parking areas. Bicycles locked to fences, gates, and handrails may be removed.

Age Limits

Children 12 years of age and younger will be admitted free to the venue, but must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times.

Clubhouse Dress Policy

Although Wyoming Downs generally allows casual attire, its Clubhouse prohibits shorts, t-shirts, halter tops, tennis shoes, sandals, and other casual attire. The Clubhouse affords guests an opportunity to view our live racing and enjoy food and beverage in a reserved, upscale area. Please adhere to the spirit of this experience in complying with our code.
